DAY 1 (16 Mar 2026)

ARRIVE COPENHAGEN

- 1.30pm Arrival at Copenhagen Airport
- Take the airport metro to hotel
- Free and easy in the afternoon, adjust to the time difference
- *Optional : Canal Boat Tour (RM150+ per pax)*

DAY 2 (17 Mar 2026)

COPENHAGEN OSLO

- Copenhagen City Walk : Andersen Statue, City Hall, Nyhavn, Little Mermaid Statue
- Afternoon we will take the shuttle bus to the port and board the overnight ferry to Oslo, Norway, with a journey of around 17 hours in a sleeper cabin.

DAY 3 (18 Mar 2026)

OSLO LOFOTEN

- 10:00am arrive at Oslo port and transfer to Oslo airport
- Take the domestic flight from Oslo to Lofoten (1.5hr)
- Drive to Lofoten, check in and rest (1.5hr)

LOFOTEN

- Drive around Lofoten E10 road trip (4hr)
- Enjoy the breathtaking landscapes of fjords, mountains, and Arctic coastlines

LOFOTEN

- Today, we will explore Lofoten Islands
- Along the way, visit iconic fishing villages like Reine and Hamnøy, showcasing the traditional red houses typical of Lofoten

DAY 6 (21 Mar 2026)

LOFOTEN - ABISKO

- Today, we will travel to Abisko Sweden (3hr)
- Enjoy the stunning fjords, mountains, and coastal scenery, experiencing the typical natural beauty
- *Optional : Abisko Aurora Chasing (RM450+ per pax)*

DAY 7 (22 Mar 2026)

ABISKO - TROMSO

- Drive to Tromsø, one of northern Norway's largest cities (3hr)
- Tromsø : the largest urban center within the Arctic Circle, known as the "Gateway to the Arctic"
- Tromsø City Walk : Tromsø Bridge, Tromsø Cathedral, Storgata
- *Optional : Fjellheisen Cable Car (RM250+ pp), Polaria (RM150+ pp)*

DAY 8 (23 Mar 2026)

TROMSO ✈️ ROVANIEMI

- Drive to Tromsø Airport, take a flight to Rovaniemi in Finland, famously known as the "Hometown of Santa Claus" (1hr)
- Santa Claus Village: Santa Claus Office, Arctic Circle Landmark, and Santa Claus Post Office

DAY 9 (24 Mar 2026)

ROVANIEMI

- Today you can join optional activities such as reindeer sledding, husky sledding, snowmobiling, and Ice Floating
- If weather permitting at night, you may have the opportunity to admire the stunning Northern Lights

DAY 10 (25 Mar 2026)

ROVANIEMI HELSINKI

- Morning Rovaniemi City Walk : the world's northernmost McDonald's, Lordi's Square, Kemijoki River, Sampokeskus Mall
- This evening, board the overnight train bound for Helsinki, Finland's capital (12.5hr)

DAY 11 (26 Mar 2026)

HELSINKI

- Arrival at Helsinki train station, walk to hotel and check-in
- Helsinki City Walk : Stockmann Street, Kauppatori, Helsinki Cathedral, Old Market Hall
- *Optional : Helsinki Outlet*

- After check-out hotel, we will take the train to the airport, marking the end of our Nordic adventure!
