DAY 1

KL ✈️ VIENTIANE

- Fly to the capital of Laos — Vientiane
- **Wat Sisaket** : Built in 1818, is one of the oldest and best-preserved Buddhist temples in Vientiane.
- **Patuxai** : Meaning "Victory Gate," is a war monument inspired by the Arc de Triomphe in Paris.
- **Pha That Luang** : Laos's most iconic Buddhist stupa, built in the 16th century and covered in gold.
- At night, enjoy local dishes at **Vientiane's food street**, then stroll to the **Mekong Night Market** to feel the breeze

DAY 2

VIENTIANE - VANG VIENG (2hr)

- Travel to Vang Vieng, a town known for its natural beauty
- **Caving** : Explore the mysterious caves within the karst mountains
- **Blue Lagoon** : Nestled in the mountains, its clear, vibrant blue waters are cool and inviting—ideal for swimming and diving
- **Nam Song River** : Board a traditional long-tail boat and drift gently along the Nam Song River
- Evening, stroll along the river, visit Vang Vieng night market or relax with a traditional Laotian massage

DAY 3

VANG VIENG 🚆 LUANG PRABANG (1hr)

- Take the Laos Train to the UNESCO city — Luang Prabang (1hr)
- **Phousi Hill** : a climb of about 300 steps leads to panoramic views of the ancient city and the Mekong River.
- **Wat Xiengthong** : This temple showcases traditional Lao Buddhist architecture with elegant multi-tiered roofs and detailed carvings
- **Luang Prabang Night Market & Old Street** : This area features French colonial architecture and a vibrant mix of handicrafts

DAY 4

LUANG PRABANG

- **Morning Alms Giving** : Hundreds of monks in saffron robes walk in silent rows through the old town, receiving food and offerings from locals and tourists
- **Luang Prabang Morning Market** : Immerse yourself in local life and taste traditional Lao delicacies
- **Kuang Si Waterfall** : A multi-tiered cascade flowing through lush forest, creating stunning turquoise pools ideal for swimming
- **Mekong River Cruise** : Take a boat ride at sunset and enjoy the quiet villages and mountain views along the river

DAY 5

LUANG PRABANG XISHUANGBANNA (5hr)

- Take the Laos-China Railway train into China — Xishuangbanna, Yunnan (5hr)
- **Prajna Temple** : A temple that blends Dai ethnic style
- **Zongfo Temple** : One of the oldest temples in Xishuangbanna, with a history of over 1300 years
- **Gaozhuang Xishuangjing** : A vibrant destination blending Dai and Thai culture with modern nightlife

DAY 6

XISHUANGBANNA - JINGMAI MOUNTAIN (3hr)

- Travel by car to the UNESCO Jingmai Mountain, and explore ancient tea forests and historic villages (3hr)
- **Princess Banyan Tree** : An ancient banyan tree deep in the tea forest, it stands as a natural landmark in the tea mountains
- **King Bee Tree** : An ancient tree hanging with natural beehives, revered by villagers as the guardian spirit of the forest
- **Wengji Ancient Village** : A traditional Blang settlement nestled in the heart of Jingmai's protected ancient tea forest,

DAY 7

JINGMAI MOUNTAIN - XISHUANGBANNA 🚆 KUNMING (6hr)

- **Jingmai Mountain Sunrise** : Wake early and head to the viewpoint to watch the sunrise over a sea of clouds on Jingmai Mountain
- **Nuogan Ancient Village** : Perched atop the tea mountains, this village preserves ancient tea-making traditions still practiced today
- Drive to Xishuangbanna Station (3hr), then take the high-speed train to Kunming (3hr)
- **Nanqiang Night Market** : One of Kunming's liveliest night markets and a great place to experience local life and culture

KUNMING ✈️ KL

- **Haigeng Dam** : Thousands of seagulls migrate from Siberia to spend the winter here, creating a breathtaking spectacle
- **Zhuanxin Farmers' Market** : A lively Kunming market showcasing authentic Yunnan snacks, fresh seasonal produce, and wild mushrooms—offering a true local experience
- **Kunming Old Street**
- **Nanping Walking Street** : Kunming's busiest shopping district, perfect for buying souvenirs and local specialties
